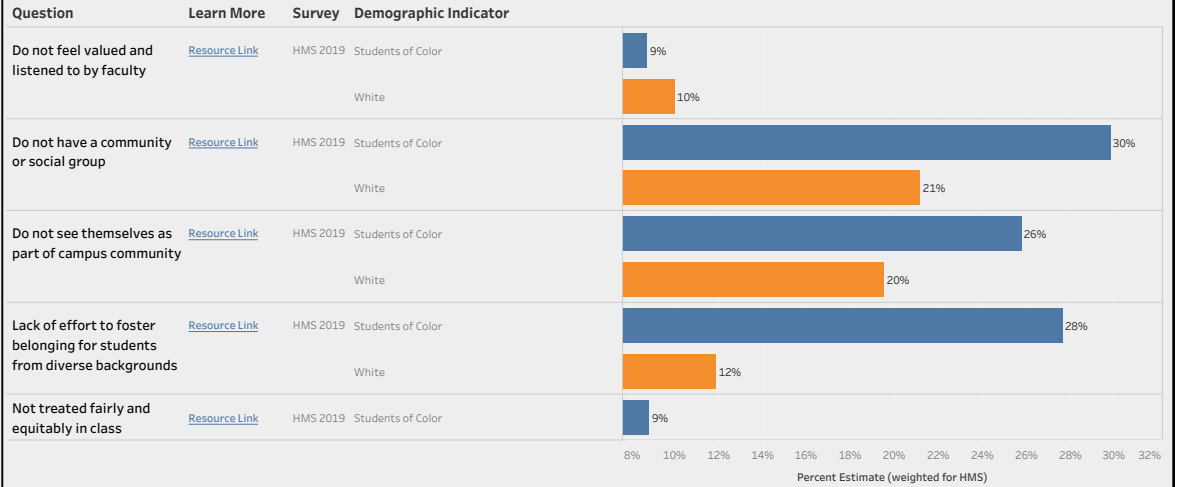


Campus Climate

Perceiving oneself as belonging on campus is important for student health and well-being. At UW-Madison, first generation students are less likely to see themselves as part of the campus community, and gender diverse students are less likely to feel valued and listened to by faculty. In addition, students of color are much less likely to believe that UW-Madison has made an effort to help students from diverse backgrounds experience a sense of belonging on campus.

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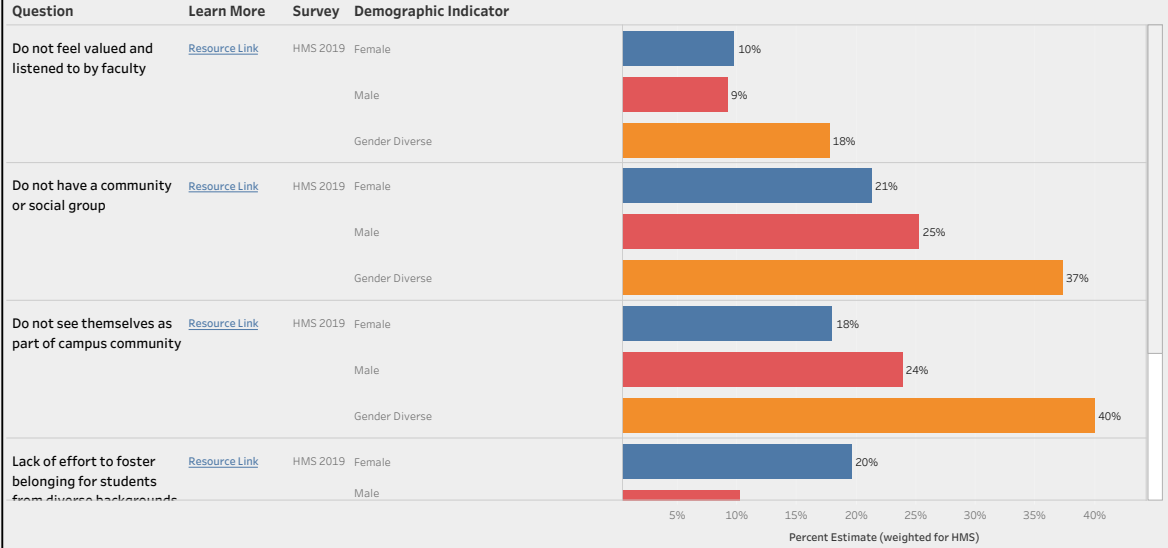


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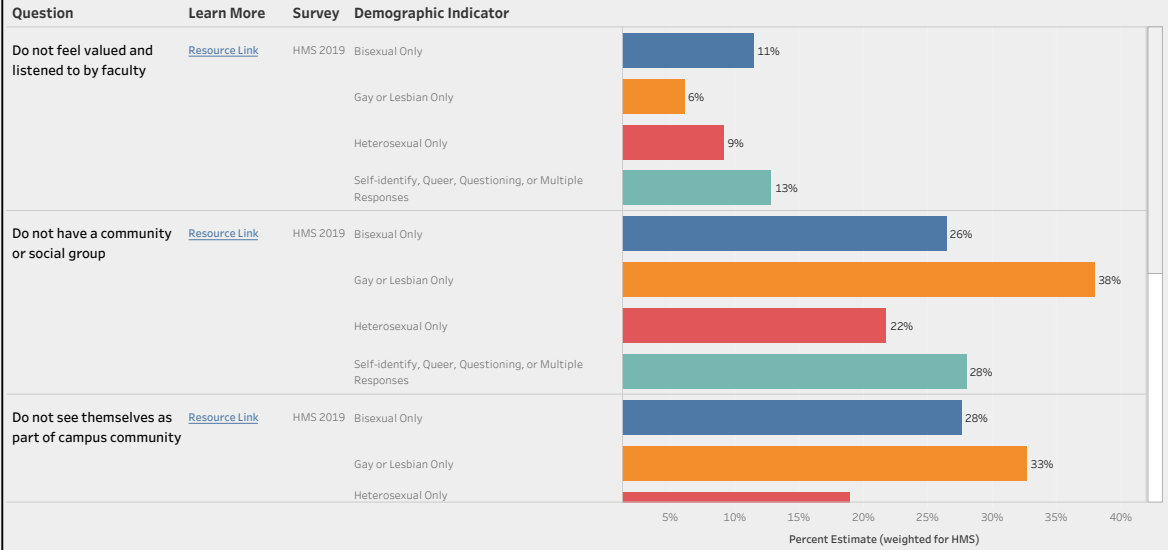


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
